Washington, DC – The DC Latino Caucus, in partnership with the National Association of Hispanic Journalists – DC Chapter, the DC Asian American & Pacific Islanders Caucus [DCAAPI] and community partners including CapitalWirePR, will host a DC Mayoral candidates forum Saturday March 1st from 2 to 4pm at the Josephine Butler Center, 2437 15th St. NW, in Washington, DC. Maria Rosa Lucchini co-anchors the 6 and 11 PM newscasts at Univision Washington, D.C. She joined Univision Washington in 1999. He has written books on politics, religion, and the history of Latino Americans.
