WASHINGTON, DC – The Hispanic Heritage Foundation (HHF) today announced the 27th Annual Hispanic Heritage Awards will take place on September 18, 2014, at the Warner Theatre in Washington, DC. The Hispanic Heritage Awards were established in 1987 by President Ronald Reagan to commemorate the creation of Hispanic Heritage Month in America. Since that time, the Hispanic Heritage Awards are considered among the highest honors for Hispanics by Hispanics. Categories for the 2014 Awards will include Music, Vision, Legend, Sports, STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math), Leadership, Education (hosted by Target), and Inspira. Top Latino performers and personalities will pay tribute to the Honorees from the stage.

The Awards are unique in that celebrities take the stage along with educators, innovators, community and business leaders, elected officials, and others. The Awards are supported by nearly 40 national Hispanic-serving institutions who co-host the program.
